

RESUMPTIVE

Meaning: Resumptive (adjective): relating to a clause or phrase that restates or summarizes previously mentioned information for clarity or emphasis.

1. The resumptive clause in her essay effectively clarified her main argument.
2. In his speech, he used a resumptive phrase to emphasize the key points he had just made.
3. The resumptive structure in the poem added a rhythmic quality that enhanced its emotional impact.
4. She included a resumptive summary at the end of the report to reinforce the findings.
5. The lawyer employed a resumptive statement to tie together the various pieces of evidence presented.
