

# RESUPINATED

*Meaning: Resupinated refers to the process in which leaves or plant parts twist or turn to a position where the upper surface faces downward, often to optimize light exposure.*

1. The botanist observed that the leaves had resupinated, allowing them to capture more sunlight.
2. During the experiment, the team noted how the seedlings resupinated after being rotated under the light.
3. In some orchids, the flowers are resupinated, which aids in pollination by attracting specific insects.
4. The resupinated position of the plant's stem provided a unique advantage in its natural habitat.
5. As the plant grew, it resupinated its leaves, adapting to the changing environmental conditions.

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
