Meaning: Retaliating refers to the act of responding to an action, typically an attack or offense, with a similar or opposing action.

1. The country began retaliating against the sanctions imposed by its neighbors.
2. She found herself constantly retaliating to the harsh comments made by her colleagues.
3. After being unfairly criticized, he felt a strong urge to start retaliating in kind.
4. The team took the loss personally, retaliating with a fierce determination in the next match.
5. Retaliating against your opponents can sometimes escalate conflicts rather than resolve them.

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
