Meaning: Retraction: the act of withdrawing or taking back a statement, claim, or publication, often due to errors or misleading information.

1. The retraction of the statement sparked a heated debate among the members of the committee.
2. After much deliberation, the scientist issued a formal retraction of her previously published research.
3. He felt a sense of relief after the retraction of the allegations against him was announced.
4. The journal's reputation was at stake following the unexpected retraction of several articles.
5. In academic publishing, a retraction is a serious matter that can affect an author's credibility.
