Meaning: Reticency refers to the quality of being reserved or reluctant to share thoughts or feelings.

1. Her reticency during the meeting made it difficult for the team to gauge her true feelings about the project.
2. Despite his reticency in sharing personal details, his colleagues respected his boundaries.
3. The artist's reticency added an air of mystery to her work, leaving viewers eager to interpret its meaning.
