Meaning: Retoucher (verb): to make adjustments or enhancements to an image, typically in terms of color, sharpness, or detail, to improve its overall appearance.

3. He hired a professional to retoucher the wedding photos before sending them to the album designer.
4. It's common for artists to retoucher their work digitally to achieve the desired effect.
