Meaning: Retraction: the act of withdrawing or taking back a statement, claim, or publication, typically due to its inaccuracy or falsehood.

1. The newspaper issued a retraction after realizing the story was based on false information.
2. Following the controversy, the scientist published a retraction of her earlier research findings.
3. His public retraction of the misleading statement was seen as a step towards rebuilding trust.
4. The company's retraction of their misleading advertisement was welcomed by consumer advocacy groups.
5. After receiving backlash, the politician announced a retraction of his previous remarks regarding the policy.
