Meaning: Retract: to withdraw or take back a statement, claim, or publication, especially after recognizing an error or misinterpretation.

1. The scientist had to retract the paper after discovering a critical error in the data.
2. She decided to retract her statement after realizing it could be misinterpreted.
3. The publisher agreed to retract the book due to the author's controversial views.
4. In light of new evidence, he chose to retract his previous claims about the incident.
5. The organization took swift action to retract the misleading advertisement.
