Meaning: Retroactive refers to something that takes effect from a date in the past, affecting situations or conditions that existed before its implementation.

1. The new law will have retroactive effects, impacting those who were previously exempt.

3. The company announced a retroactive bonus for all employees who had been with them for over a year.
4. His retroactive tax refund was a pleasant surprise, coming months after he filed his return.
5. The court's decision was retroactive, meaning it applied to cases that had already been resolved.
