*Meaning: Retroactively means applying a decision or policy to events or cases that occurred before the decision was made.*

1. The new policy will apply retroactively to all cases submitted since the beginning of the year.
2. The court decided to retroactively enforce the law, affecting many previous rulings.
3. Employees were pleased to learn that their bonuses would be calculated retroactively, granting them additional compensation.
4. Retroactively adjusting the tax rates allowed the government to correct earlier discrepancies in revenue collection.
5. The organization announced that it would retroactively honor previous commitments made to its volunteers.
