Meaning: Revocable: capable of being revoked or canceled; subject to withdrawal or annulment.

1. The contract included a clause stating that it was revocable at any time with proper notice.

3. In many jurisdictions, power of attorney agreements are revocable if the grantor decides to cancel them.
