Meaning: Revocate: to officially withdraw or annul a decision, policy, or endorsement.

1. The committee decided to revoke the controversial policy after public outcry.
2. After careful consideration, they chose to revoke their previous endorsement of the candidate.
3. The board has the authority to revoke licenses that do not meet the necessary standards.
4. In light of new evidence, the judge moved to revoke the earlier ruling.
5. He wanted to revoke his acceptance of the job offer before it became official.
