

REVOKER

Meaning: Revoker: a person or entity that formally cancels or withdraws a previously agreed-upon contract or proposal.

1. The revoker of the contract made it clear that no further negotiations would be entertained.
2. In the meeting, the revoker explained the rationale behind their decision to withdraw the proposal.
3. A revoker has the authority to eliminate previously granted permissions in the system.
4. She felt relieved when the revoker of the policy announced its cancellation, restoring her rights.
5. The judge acted as a revoker, nullifying the previous ruling that had caused significant distress.
