Meaning: Revokingly: in a manner that expresses regret or disapproval regarding a decision or action.

1. She looked at him revokingly, as if to say that his decision was deeply regrettable.
2. The committee addressed the proposal revokingly, acknowledging the potential consequences of their actions.
3. In her tone, there was a revokingly stern quality that left no room for negotiation.
4. He spoke revokingly about the promises made, reflecting on the weight of their implications.
5. The judge glanced at the defendant revokingly before delivering the final verdict.
