

RHIZINE

Meaning: Rhizine is a root-like structure in certain fungi and lichens that anchors the organism to a surface and provides stability.

1. The rhizine anchors the lichen to the surface, providing stability and support.
2. In botany, the rhizine is often compared to roots, but it serves a different function.
3. Fungi and some algae form a symbiotic relationship in lichens, with rhizines playing a key role.
4. The study of rhizines has revealed much about the adaptability of lichens in harsh environments.
