

RHIZOME

Meaning: A rhizome is an underground stem that grows horizontally and can produce new shoots and roots, often serving as a storage organ for plants.

1. The rhizome of the ginger plant is often used in cooking for its spicy flavor.
2. In botany, a rhizome serves as an underground stem that can produce new shoots and roots.
3. Some plants, like bamboo, spread quickly through their extensive rhizome networks.
