

# RHONCHUS

*Meaning: Rhonchus is a continuous, low-pitched sound heard in the lungs during breathing, often associated with airway obstruction or secretions.*

1. The doctor noted a rhonchus in the patient's lung sounds during the examination.
2. As the nurse listened with the stethoscope, she detected a pronounced rhonchus indicative of bronchial obstruction.
3. The presence of a rhonchus often suggests the accumulation of secretions in the airways.
4. In patients with chronic bronchitis, rhonchi can be a common finding during respiratory assessments.
5. Recognizing the characteristics of a rhonchus is essential for diagnosing underlying respiratory conditions.
