Meaning: Rictal refers to the specialized feathers located around the mouth or beak of a bird, often associated with vocalizations or display during flight.

1. The rictal feathers of the bird flared beautifully as it took flight.
2. A rictal call can often be heard during the mating season of many species.
3. The rictal bristles around the beak help the bird detect its surroundings.
4. During the nature walk, we observed a rictal display in the local avian population.
5. Photographers often aim to capture the intricate details of a bird's rictal area.
