Meaning: Rictus: a fixed or unnatural facial expression, often indicating pain, distress, or a lack of genuine emotion.

1. The rictus of the corpse gave a chilling reminder of the tragedy that had unfolded.
2. She smiled with a rictus that suggested more discomfort than joy at the unexpected compliment.
3. The actor's performance was so gripping that the audience was left with rictus expressions of horror.
4. In the photograph, his rictus hinted at a moment frozen in both joy and pain.
5. As the clown performed, his exaggerated rictus brought laughter, masking the sadness beneath.
