

RIGHT-ABOUT

Meaning: Right-about refers to a command or action instructing someone or something to turn around to face the opposite direction.

1. The soldier executed a perfect right-about face during the drill.
2. After the brief pause, the dog turned right-about to follow its owner.
3. In the dance routine, the performers seamlessly executed a right-about turn.
4. She called out for her friend, who was walking right-about the corner of the street.
5. The coach instructed the team to right-about and regroup in the center of the field.
