Meaning: Rile: to irritate or annoy someone, often causing agitation or provocation.

1. Her constant interruptions began to rile the speaker during the presentation.
2. The unfair decision seemed designed to rile the fans and provoke a reaction.
3. Even the smallest criticism can rile him up and lead to an argument.
4. She tried to remain calm, but his teasing remarks continued to rile her emotions.
5. The noisy construction outside was enough to rile the usually peaceful neighborhood.
