

# RITARDANDO

*Meaning: Ritardando is a musical term indicating a gradual slowing down of tempo.*

1. The conductor signaled a ritardando, allowing the orchestra to gradually slow down for the final crescendo.
2. As the piano piece progressed, the performer skillfully incorporated a ritardando to enhance the emotional impact of the music.
3. The composer instructed the musicians to apply a ritardando at the end of the movement for a more dramatic effect.
4. During the rehearsal, the choir director emphasized the importance of a well-executed ritardando to convey the piece's reflective mood.
5. In the last few bars of the song, a ritardando created a poignant moment that left the audience in awe.
