Meaning: ROUGHDRAW (verb): to create a preliminary or rough sketch or outline of a subject or idea.

1. The artist began to roughdraw the landscape before refining the details.
2. After a few minutes of brainstorming, she decided to roughdraw her ideas in a sketchbook.
3. Using charcoal, he could quickly roughdraw the figure to capture its essence.
4. In the early stages of the project, the team would roughdraw the layout to visualize their concepts.
5. His ability to roughdraw complex scenes made him a valuable asset during the design phase.
