*Meaning: To roughhew means to shape or cut a material roughly or in a preliminary manner before refining it further.*

2. In woodworking, it's common to roughhew the logs before crafting them into furniture.
3. The architect instructed the crew to roughhew the foundation to expedite the building process.
4. He plans to roughhew the manuscript and then edit it later for clarity and style.
5. To ensure a strong starting point, the sculptor chose to roughhew the marble block.
