Meaning: Roughshod: acting in a domineering or oppressive manner, disregarding the rights or concerns of others.

3. His roughshod approach to leadership alienated many of his team members, who felt undervalued.

5. Despite the warning signs, the politician's campaign ran roughshod over community concerns, prioritizing profits over people.
