

RUFFED

Meaning: 'RUFFED' refers to the action of making a sound similar to a bark or growl, as in the case of a dog, or to fluffing or raising feathers, especially in birds, often for display purposes.

1. The dog ruffed playfully as it chased after the thrown ball.
2. She ruffed her feathers to look more impressive during the mating display.
3. The chef ruffed the salad greens, ensuring they were properly washed and dried.
4. As the storm approached, the trees ruffed in the strong winds, rustling their leaves.
5. He ruffed his collar before stepping into the formal event, wanting to appear polished.
