Meaning: Rattle (verb): to make a soft, rustling sound, often associated with movement or agitation, as in the gentle noise of brushes or leaves.

1. The artist's rattle of brushes created a soothing rhythm in the studio.
2. As the storm approached, the leaves began to rattle in the wind.
3. The old engine would rattle to life after a few tries, much to the mechanic's relief.
4. During the presentation, her nervousness caused her voice to rattle slightly.
