Meaning: Sabotage: the act of deliberately obstructing or undermining a person's efforts or a project's success.

1. The investigation revealed that someone had attempted to sabotage the company's new product launch.
2. In a fit of jealousy, she tried to sabotage her rival's performance during the competition.
3. Vandalism can often be seen as a form of sabotage against the community's efforts to improve public spaces.
4. The team's success was overshadowed by rumors of internal sabotage that led to mistrust among members.
5. He was accused of trying to sabotage the negotiations by leaking confidential information to the press.

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
