

SACCHARIZE

Meaning: SACCHARIZE (verb): to convert starch or cellulose into simpler sugars through enzymatic or chemical processes.

1. The process to saccharize starch involves breaking it down into simpler sugars through enzymatic action.
2. Researchers were excited to discover a new method to saccharize cellulose, making it more accessible for biofuel production.
3. To saccharize the fruit, the chef gently heated it with sugar until the natural juices released and caramelized.
