Meaning: SACCULAR: relating to a sac or pouch-like structure, often involved in functions such as balance or buoyancy in biological systems.

1. The saccular structure of the ear is crucial for maintaining balance.
2. In certain fish, the saccular part of the swim bladder helps with buoyancy control.
3. Medical imaging revealed a saccular aneurysm that required immediate attention.
4. The biologist described the saccular formation in the plant's reproductive system.
5. During the dissection, they noted the saccular nature of the lung's alveoli.
