

# SAFE-CONDUCT

*Meaning: Safe-conduct refers to a document or guarantee that allows a person to pass through a hostile area without harm or interference.*

1. The diplomat was granted a safe-conduct to ensure his passage through hostile territory.
2. During the conflict, the rebels issued a safe-conduct for the humanitarian aid workers.
3. The king provided a safe-conduct for the merchant, allowing him to travel without fear of attack.
