

# SAGITTAL

*Meaning: Sagittal refers to a plane or cut in anatomy that divides the body into left and right halves, typically parallel to the midline.*

1. The sagittal plane divides the body into left and right halves.
2. In anatomy, the term sagittal is often used to describe cuts made parallel to the midline.
3. During the dissection, the professor pointed out the sagittal structures of the brain.
4. Radiologists frequently use sagittal imaging to better visualize spinal alignment.
5. Understanding the sagittal axis is crucial in biomechanics for analyzing movement.
