Meaning: Sand-blind (adj.): temporarily unable to see clearly due to sand irritation or exposure, often resulting from harsh desert conditions.

1. The sun beat down mercilessly, leaving the travelers sand-blind in the vast desert.
2. His eyes were sand-blind after hours of navigating the dunes without proper protection.
3. She squinted against the glare, feeling dangerously sand-blind as the storm approached.
4. The fierce winds whipped up the grains, rendering the hikers sand-blind and disoriented.
5. After the sudden sandstorm, many found themselves sand-blind and lost in the swirling chaos.
