Meaning: Sanded: past tense of sand; to have smoothed or polished a surface, typically wood, by rubbing it with sandpaper.

1. The carpenter sanded the wooden surface until it felt smooth to the touch.

3. She sanded the edges of the table to prevent any splinters from forming.
4. The artist sanded the canvas to create a better texture for the oil paints.
