Meaning: SARCLE (verb): To outline or emphasize the boundaries of something, often to enhance visual impact or to selectively address certain aspects in a discussion.

1. The artist decided to sarcle the edges of the canvas to create a more dynamic composition.
2. In their discussion, they agreed to sarcle the controversial topics to keep the conversation productive.
3. She used a special technique to sarcle the wood, giving the furniture a unique, handcrafted look.
4. The team was asked to sarcle the project scope to ensure clarity and focus moving forward.
5. To enhance the presentation, he chose to sarcle the less relevant data and emphasize the key findings.
