

SAWTOOTH

Meaning: Sawtooth refers to a shape or outline characterized by a series of sharp, angular peaks and valleys, resembling the teeth of a saw.

1. The mountain range featured a dramatic sawtooth profile that captivated hikers and photographers alike.
2. As the artist painted the landscape, she emphasized the sawtooth edges of the jagged peaks in the distance.
3. The architect designed the roof with a sawtooth design to maximize natural light in the studio below.

5. The sawtooth waveform on the oscilloscope indicated a rapid change in the electrical signal.
