

SCAFFOLD

Meaning: Scaffold: a temporary structure used to support workers and materials during the construction or repair of a building.

1. The workers carefully assembled the scaffold to reach the upper levels of the building.
2. To ensure safety, the scaffold was inspected daily before any construction began.
3. Artists often use a scaffold to create detailed murals on tall walls.
4. The old theater was surrounded by a scaffold as renovations were underway.
