

SCAPUS

Meaning: Scapus: a stalk-like structure that supports a flower or an organ.

1. The scapus of the flower serves as a support structure for the blooming petals.
2. In anatomy, the term 'scapus' refers to a stalk-like part of an organ.
3. The scapus of the plant is often mistaken for the stem due to its similar appearance.
4. During the dissection, the students were particularly interested in the scapus of the specimen.
5. Botanists study the scapus to understand the growth patterns of various plant species.
