

SCHISMATIZE

Meaning: To schismatize means to divide or split into factions or groups, often due to disagreements or differing beliefs.

1. The political party began to schismatize after a heated debate over its core values.
2. As disagreements intensified, the once-unified community started to schismatize into competing factions.
3. Historians often discuss how the reform movement could schismatize various religious groups.
4. Efforts to schismatize the organization were met with strong resistance from its leadership.
5. In her analysis, she warned that failing to address the issues could schismatize the group irreparably.
