

SCIENTER

Meaning: Scienter is the legal term for the intent or knowledge of wrongdoing that establishes liability in cases of fraud or securities violations.

1. The prosecution must prove that the defendant acted with scienter to establish liability in the fraud case.
2. In securities law, scienter refers to the intent or knowledge of wrongdoing that is required to impose liability on a defendant.
3. The judge emphasized the importance of demonstrating scienter in order to uphold the charges against the accused.
4. Her actions suggested a level of scienter that raised serious questions about her integrity in the transaction.
5. Without adequate evidence of scienter, the defense argued that the case should be dismissed for lack of merit.
