

SCORIE

Meaning: Scorie is a term referring to the waste material or slag produced during the smelting of metal, often consisting of impurities and non-metallic substances.

1. The scorie from the furnace was carefully collected and analyzed for its mineral content.
2. As the metal cooled, a layer of scorie formed on the surface, indicating the smelting process was complete.
3. Traditional glassmaking often utilizes scorie as a natural flux to improve the melting process.
4. The archaeologist discovered ancient scorie at the site, suggesting that metalworking had taken place centuries ago.
5. In the foundry, workers were trained to distinguish between good metal and unwanted scorie in the mixture.
