Meaning: SCRAP: to discard or abandon something in favor of a new plan or to refer to discarded material, especially metal, that is no longer usable.

3. After reviewing the proposal, the committee chose to scrap it altogether.
4. He found a scrap of paper with important notes scribbled on it.
5. They collected scrap materials to build a makeshift shelter for the night.
