*Meaning: To scraw is to write or draw hastily and carelessly, often resulting in a rough or illegible appearance.*

3. As he listened to the lecture, he began to scraw his thoughts in a frenzy.
4. She scrawled her signature across the bottom of the painting with a flourish.
5. In a moment of inspiration, he scrawled the lyrics to his new song on a napkin.
