

SCUMBLE

Meaning: Scumble: to apply a thin, opaque layer of paint over a dry layer to create a soft, blended effect or to alter the appearance of the underlying color.

1. She decided to scumble the paint to create a softer transition between the colors.
2. The artist used a dry brush technique to scumble the surface, adding depth to the landscape.
3. After applying the base coat, he began to scumble lighter shades to bring the painting to life.
4. To achieve a more textured effect, she chose to scumble the top layer of acrylics over the dried underpainting.
5. The tutorial demonstrated how to scumble with different tools to achieve various artistic effects.
