

# SCUTAL

*Meaning: Scutal refers to the shield-like bony or cartilaginous structure that forms part of the protective shell in certain reptiles, such as turtles, and is involved in their support and morphology.*

1. The scutal structure of the turtle provides both protection and support for its body.
2. Scientists examined the scutal morphology of different species to understand their evolutionary adaptations.
3. During the dissection, the researcher noted the unique patterns on the scutal plate.
4. The scutal features of the ancient fossil suggested a strong evolutionary link to modern reptiles.
5. Herpetologists often study scutal characteristics to classify and differentiate between lizard species.
