

# SCUTATE

*Meaning: Scutate refers to a flattened, shield-like shape or structure, often describing certain wing or leaf forms in insects and plants.*

1. The scutate shape of the insect's wings allowed it to glide gracefully through the air.
2. Botanists noted the scutate leaves on the new plant species discovered in the rainforest.
3. Using a scutate design, the architect created a striking façade for the modern building.
4. The scutate armor of the turtle provides excellent protection against predators.
5. In the museum, the scutate fossil was a highlight of the paleontology exhibit.
