

SCUTTER

Meaning: Scutter (verb): to move quickly and hurriedly, often in a scurrying or darting manner.

1. The children began to scutter across the playground as the bell rang.
2. A startled rabbit would often scutter away at the slightest sound.
3. Leaves would scutter along the pavement in the brisk autumn wind.
4. As the rain began to fall, the pedestrians started to scutter for cover.
5. The mice would scutter in and out of the holes in the walls, searching for crumbs.
