Meaning: A seave is a type of sieve or mesh device used for separating or filtering materials, such as fish or debris, typically in water.

1. The fisherman used a seave to separate the small fish from the larger catch.
2. After the storm, a seave filled with debris was left along the shore.
3. In his experiments, he employed a seave to filter out impurities from the liquid.
4. The ancient method of using a seave for cooking grains is still practiced in some cultures.
5. As the artist painted, she carefully used a seave to create delicate textures on the canvas.
