*Meaning: To seclude means to isolate oneself from others or to remove oneself from social interaction for the purpose of solitude or reflection.*

1. She decided to seclude herself in the mountains for a week of solitude and reflection.
2. The author often secludes himself in a quiet cabin to find inspiration for his next novel.
3. During the retreat, participants were encouraged to seclude themselves from technology and distractions.
4. He sought to seclude the injured bird in a safe place until it could recover.
5. The ancient monastery was built in a remote area, allowing monks to seclude themselves from the outside world.
