Meaning: 'Seen' is the past participle of 'see,' meaning to have perceived or observed something with the eyes.

4. They had seen many places during their travels, but none compared to the mountains.

6. I have never seen such a beautiful sunset before.
7. She had seen the movie several times before recommending it to her friends.
8. After the storm passed, I had never seen the landscape look so serene.
9. He was surprised to learn that the painting he admired had been seen by millions.
10. They had seen each other only once since their graduation years ago.
